**RE: COVID-19 POSITIVE RESIDENT CASE AT JGJ NURSING HOME**

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Hello everyone,

As you know, we learned yesterday that one of our staff members in our nursing home, who was asymptomatic, tested positive for COVID-19. We continue to work very closely with the department of health following every precautionary measure. Additionally, on this date, we underwent an infection control survey conducted by the department of health. We received positive feedback and results demonstrated successful compliance with all regulations and guidelines related to infection control.

However, unfortunately, despite all proper protocol and precautionary measures in place, in our enhanced monitoring and increased surveillance of residents and testing, a resident on unit one had developed symptoms and tested positive for COVID-19. The resident is isolated in a private room and the entire unit as well as unit two and unit three remain on enhanced contact droplet precautions with full and proper use of PPE by all staff to prevent any spread.

At this time, every other resident who has been tested, results were negative and we continue to closely monitor every resident. We want to reassure you that we are doing everything possible to avoid the spread. Please be aware that our screening entrance for end of life visits was moved due to the precautions and is now located in the back side of building.
