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Hello everyone,

As you know, we experienced our first case of COVID-19 in one of our residents in the nursing home this past week on unit one. I am deeply saddened to inform you that the resident has since passed away. These are very difficult and challenging times only compounded when we lose one of our residents. Our deepest condolences are with the family.

All infection control protocols continue and the units remain on enhanced contact droplet precautions. We continue to closely monitor residents for symptoms. At this time, all residents who have been tested remain free of COVID-19. At present, we do not have any other positive cases throughout the nursing home or campus.

Should any resident develop symptoms and require testing, we will promptly reach out to the emergency contact. Again, please remember that our screening entrance for end of life visits continue to occur at the back side of the building. We must continue to enforce visitor restrictions, therefore, please do not hesitate to reach out to our staff who can assist with keeping you updated and in contact with your loved one.
