RE: COVID-19 UPDATE/VISITATION

Hello everyone,

As a result of mandated routine COVID-19 testing of all employees, we learned on this date that a Hilltop employee who was asymptomatic, tested positive for COVID-19. This employee last worked on Monday, October 12th and is now home on mandatory quarantine. The employee followed all infection control protocols and guidelines wearing proper PPE at all times. The employee did not have direct contact with residents. To remain in accordance with the guidelines set forth by the Department of Health, all scheduled outdoor visitation for the Hilltop Adult Care must be halted and will remain on hold until the appropriate criteria is again met.

JGJ Nursing Home continues to meet the Department of Health guidelines and able to continue with scheduled visitations. Again, any positive case of COVID-19 among residents or staff in JGJ will halt visitations.

All residents in Hilltop and JGJ remain COVID free. Should a resident develop symptoms, we will promptly reach out to the primary contact and test as appropriate.

We are very appreciative of all your support and understanding during these tremendously difficult times. United Methodist Homes Hilltop Campus will continue to work very hard to prevent COVID-19 from entering our facilities and follow all measures set forth by the local and state departments of health while remaining compassionate and providing support to all residents and families.

Again, we want to remind everyone to continue to do all you can to help fight COVID-19 in our communities by following the recommendations set forth by the CDC.
