VISITATION GUIDELINES

ALL VISITS MUST BE SCHEDULED IN ADVANCE THROUGH OUR ACTIVITIES DEPARTMENT.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Visiting Hours: Mon - Fri 9AM - 4PM and Wed 5PM - 8PM

- **VISITS WILL TAKE PLACE IN DESIGNATED VISITING AREAS.** Outdoor visitation continues but indoor visits are now also permitted. Visitors are not permitted in resident rooms or any other area outside the designated visiting areas.
- Visits are limited to **NO MORE THAN TWO (2) VISITORS AT A TIME PER RESIDENT.** Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- **ALL VISITORS ARE REQUIRED TO BE SCREENED PRIOR TO COMING ON CAMPUS.** On the day of your visit, a representative from our Activities Department will call you to conduct a screening over the phone. Your screening will cover all symptoms related to COVID-19 and will include questions related to travel and exposure.
- All visitors are required to sign in and **PROVIDE CURRENT CONTACT INFORMATION.**
- **UPON ARRIVAL FOR YOUR VISIT AN ON-SITE SCREENING WILL OCCUR.** Your screening will verify that you remain free of COVID-19 symptoms and are not running a fever. Those with a temperature of 100° or greater will not be permitted to visit.
- **A MASK OR FACE COVERING THAT COVERS YOUR NOSE AND MOUTH MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES** throughout the visit. Visitors are asked to bring their own mask. This includes anyone ages 2 and up.
- **YOU WILL BE ASKED TO USE HAND SANITIZER,** which will be provided, prior to your visit.
- **NO PHYSICAL CONTACT WITH RESIDENTS WILL BE PERMITTED.** A staff member will review social distancing requirements and visiting areas will be marked delineating the 6 foot distance that will need to be maintained between the resident and visitor(s).
- **EACH VISIT WILL BE LIMITED TO 20-30 MINUTES** in order to allow for proper sanitation of surfaces prior to the next visitor.

If at any time we experience an increase in COVID-19 cases or respiratory symptoms, visitation will be restricted until determined safe by UMH administration and the Department of Health.
